

## SOUTH AUSTRALIA, TASMANIA AND MELBOURNE WORLD CLASS EXPLORING AND AUSTRALIA'S GREATEST GOLF COURSES BY PRIVATE AIR TERMS & CONDITIONS

Please read the following information carefully. After reading the Terms and Conditions herein (the "Agreement"), in order for your reservation to be completed, you must indicate your acceptance of the terms of the Agreement by signing and submitting the Reservation Form, along with the deposit to TCS World Travel ("TCS"), 3131 Elliott Avenue, Suite 300, Seattle, WA 98121, a qualified tour operator will organize and administer the South Australia, Tasmania and Melbourne World Class Exploring And Australia's Greatest Golf Courses By Private Air expedition (the "Tour"). TCS is responsible to you for administering the services in connection with Gabe Golf who will provide all services and accommodations on the tour. In the absence of gross negligence on TCS and Gabe Golf's part, TCS and Gabe Golf are not responsible for personal injury or property damage caused by the air carrier, hotel, or other suppliers of any services being offered in connection with the Tour. The acceptance of your Reservation Form and deposit by TCS and Gabe Golf creates a contractual relationship between you, the passenger/participant (Participant), in the Tour administered by TCS and provided by Gabe Golf.

**Reservations and Payments:** To reserve your place on the Tour, complete and sign the Reservation Form and return it with your deposit of \$5,000 per person. The deposit can be made by check; wire transfer; or by a major credit card such as Visa, MasterCard and American Express. **Make checks payable to TCS World Travel** or you may pay your initial deposit by credit card. Deposits are fully refundable until you sign the Reservation Form. Please fax or mail the completed form to TCS World Travel, 3131 Elliott Avenue, Suite 300, Seattle, WA 98121; fax to 206-447-7717. Or call 800-454-4149 or 206-254-0228. **Final payment is due June 10, 2016** and is payable by check or wire transfer only, made out to TCS World Travel as set forth below. If the Tour is fully booked when your Reservation Form is received, your payment will be returned within 7 days, or with your authorization, TCS and Gabe Golf may retain the deposit and place your name on a waiting list in the event other Participants cancel their reservations. Even if you authorize TCS and Gabe Golf to put your name on a waiting list and retain your deposit, Gabe Golf will notify you within 7 days that the Tour is fully booked.

**Security Agreement:** Your payments are held in a secure account at The Commerce Bank of Washington ("TCBW"), 601 Union Street, Suite 3600, Seattle, WA 98101-1342. Participants are protected by a Letter of Credit #592 issued by TCBW (the "Security Agreement"). Any claims against this Security Agreement must be filed with TCS or TCBW within 60 days of the termination of the Tour. After that time, TCS and TCBW will be released from liability under the Security Agreement.

**Journey Price:** The Tour price of \$28,950 per person (double occupancy) with a \$5,900 single supplement. **What is Included:** Transportation by a privately chartered Air Adventure Cessna Conquest II and a B200 Commuter Aircraft; all taxes; lodging; accommodations and airport transfers where applicable from the beginning of the journey arriving at Adelaide Airport, Australia on October 15, 2016 to the end of the journey departing Hobart International Airport on Oct. 27, 2016; excursions; group transportation; a complimentary golf bag; a program of special events and activities; meals are included (with the exception of dinners in Melbourne and two dinners in Hobart) from dinner at Kangaroo Island on October 15, 2016 until breakfast on October 27, 2016 in Hobart; golf as listed in itinerary; services of professional staff; bottled water during the Tour; complimentary Internet access in hotels where available; tips or gratuities to local guides, drivers, porters, and wait staff; amenities package; \$100,000 medical evacuation insurance (which includes minimal accident/sickness/baggage insurance) for covered reasons. The exact Tour itinerary, name and location of hotels, length of stay at each hotel, and other ground accommodations and services, are set forth in the itinerary, which is a part of this Agreement. **Not included in the price** is commercial airfare between your home city and Adelaide, Australia and from Hobart, Australia to your home city; dinners in Melbourne and two dinners in Hobart; optional and additional accident/baggage/cancellation insurance; passport and Australia visa fees; personal expenses such as laundry, telephone, and fax fees; shopping; excess baggage fees; all beverages not mentioned above as included; hotel mini-bar charges; meals not scheduled by Gabe Golf; inoculation and medication costs of any kind. Any tips or gratuities not specifically mentioned as included in the total Tour price will be at your discretion. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the expedition price that you voluntarily do not use.

**Insurance:** TCS and Gabe Golf strongly recommends this important protection, which can save you money if you are forced to cancel or alter your trip. Insurance premium payments are nonrefundable. Information will be sent at time of your deposit.

**Baggage:** On the private plane, each participant is limited to 50 lbs total for all bags, to include one golf bag, one mid-sized bag and one small hand carry.

**Aircraft:** The private jet flights will be performed using an Air Adventure Cessna Conquest II and a Lukas Air B200 Commuter Aircraft. The operators reserve the right to substitute equivalent aircraft if necessary.

**Flights:** The operation of these flights is subject to the foreign governments involved granting landing rights for the flight. If the air carrier cannot obtain

these rights for any particular flight leg of the Tour, that flight leg will be canceled and alternative arrangements may be made, at the discretion of Gabe Golf.

**Cancellations and Refunds: If you cancel your reservation or change your plans, your right to receive a refund is limited,** as set forth in the following schedule. All cancellations will become effective as of the date of the postmark or email receipt. All requests for refunds must be sent to Gabe Golf in writing via mail, fax or email.

Refunds will be made within 14 days of receipt of your notice of cancellation.

Leaving the Tour in progress, for any reason whatsoever, will not result in a refund, and no refunds will be made for any unused portions of the Tour. If you cancel and are able to provide a substitute Participant for the Tour, you will receive a full refund of money paid toward the price less, an administrative charge of \$25 for effecting the substitution once the substitute Participant has paid in full. If Gabe Golf must cancel the Tour in its entirety, Gabe Golf will notify you in writing within 7 days of the cancellation, but in no event later than 10 days before the scheduled departure date. Gabe Golf has no right to cancel the Tour less than 10 days before departure, except for circumstances that make it physically impossible to perform the Tour. If that occurs, Gabe Golf will notify you as soon as possible, but not later than the scheduled departure date. The rights and remedies made available under this contract are in addition to any other rights or remedies available under applicable law. However, Gabe Golf offers refunds under this Agreement with the express understanding that the receipt of that refund by a Participant waives the additional remedies.

**Itinerary Changes:** The itinerary and staff are subject to modification and change by Gabe Golf. Every reasonable effort will be made to operate the Tour as planned; however, should unforeseen world events and conditions require our itinerary to be altered, Gabe Golf reserves the right to do so for the safety and best interest of the group.

**Single Accommodations and Suite Upgrades:** Single rooms are available at extra cost with limited availability. Suite rooms may be available but are limited on this itinerary. More information about them, including their additional costs, will be available to you in the months before departure by Gabe Golf.

**Airfare:** We are happy to assist you in reserving commercial flights between your home city and **Adelaide** and from **Hobart** to your home city, in the class of service that you prefer. Please ask for details.

**Visa Documents/Entry Permits:** A visa is required for **Australia** and should be obtained through the air agent issuing your ticket or through a visa service. Visa forms will be sent to you at time of confirmation. Please provide a color photocopy of your passport to TCS and Gabe Golf at the time of registration for this purpose. Your passport must be valid until at least **April 28, 2017** if not extending your tour dates. Failure to obtain a valid passport and visa does not negate the terms and conditions and is the responsibility of the participant.

**Health Requirements:** This is an active program, which requires you to make a realistic assessment of your health. All Participants are expected to be in active good health, to enjoy traveling as part of a group, and to be ready to experience cultural differences with grace. Walking and climbing stairs are required in many hotels and airports, to board the aircraft, and as part of many excursions. Prior to traveling, we highly recommend visiting your personal physician for a check-up, so that you may discuss your ability to participate in this type of journey. For the latest recommendations on specific health precautions for the areas you will visit, consult your physician and the Centers for Disease Control. Any physical condition requiring special attention, diet, or treatment should be reported in writing when the reservation is made. We will make reasonable efforts to accommodate Participants with special needs; however, we cannot accommodate wheelchairs. If you require a slower pace, extra assistance, or the use of a cane or walking stick, arrangements will be made for private touring at each destination, if necessary, at the discretion of our Tour staff. Any extra cost for such arrangements will be the responsibility of the Participant. If you would like to forego some of the scheduled activities to rejuvenate and relax, please feel free to do so at any time.

**Photography and Video:** We reserve the right to take photographs or videos (the "Photography") during the Tour and to use the Photography for promotional purposes. Participants who prefer their images not be used must notify us in writing before the commencement of the Tour.

**Basis of Rates:** All prices are based on two persons sharing a room. All prices and fares are quoted in U.S. dollars. The rates are based on current

tariffs and are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. While Gabe Golf will make reasonable efforts to maintain the listed prices, if it is necessary to levy a surcharge, Gabe Golf reserves the right to do so and will notify you at the time of final invoicing. Gabe Golf reserves the right to cancel the Tour because of inadequate enrolls words this is now copy olment that makes the Tour economically infeasible to operate. In such a case, a full refund of the Tour cost will be made.

**Release of Liability:** The passenger tickets in use by the carriers shall constitute the sole contract between the carriers and the passenger; the carriers are not responsible for any act, omission, or event during the time expedition Participants are not aboard their conveyance. Neither TCS nor Gabe Golf or any of its respective owners, directors, employees, contractors, officers or agents (collectively, the "Released Parties") shall be held liable for (A) any damage to, or loss of, property or injury to, or death of, persons occasioned directly or indirectly by an act or omission of any other provider, including but not limited to any defect in any aircraft, watercraft, or vehicle operated or provided by such other provider, (B) any loss or damage due to delay, cancellation, or disruption in any manner caused by the laws, regulations, acts or failures to act, demands, orders, or interpositions of any government or any subdivision or agent thereof, or by acts of God, strikes, fire, flood, war, rebellion, terrorism, insurrection, sickness, quarantine, epidemics, theft, or any other cause(s) beyond their control, and (C) any and all claims, actions, or losses for bodily injury, property damage, wrongful death, loss of services, lost profits, consequential, exemplary, indirect or punitive damages or otherwise that may arise out of or occur during your travel in connection with the Tour. The Participant waives any claim against any of the Released Parties for any such loss, damage, injury, or death, including any right to seek consequential, punitive or exemplary damages against any of the Released Parties for any reason whatsoever. None of the Released Parties shall be liable for any air carrier's cancellation penalty incurred by the purchase of a nonrefundable ticket.

**Acknowledgment of Risk:** You understand and acknowledge that your travel in connection with and participation in the Tour or any activities which may take place during the Tour, may involve risk and potential exposure to injury or fatal injury and that risk and dangers may arise or be caused by the negligence or participation of other Participants, contractors, and/or subcontractors for the Tour or from other foreseeable and unforeseeable causes including weather and other acts of nature.

**Express Assumption of Risk and Responsibility:** In recognition of the inherent risk of the travels and related activities in which you are intending to engage, you confirm that you are physically and mentally capable of participating in the Tour and that you willingly and voluntarily assume full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage suffered by you or caused by you. By registering for the Tour, you certify that you do not have any mental, physical or other condition or disability that would create a hazard for yourself or other Participants. Gabe Golf reserves the right in its sole discretion to accept, decline to accept or remove any Participant on the Tour and reserves the right, subject to the terms and conditions contained herein, to withdraw any part or all of the Tour and to make such changes as may be necessary.

**Arbitration:** Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement or the performance there under, including without limitation any claim related to bodily injury, property damage or death, shall be settled by binding arbitration in Seattle, Washington, U.S.A., in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association then existing, and judgment on the arbitration award may be entered in any court having jurisdiction over the subject matter of the controversy. Such proceedings will be governed by substantive Washington law. This agreement to arbitrate does not waive or modify the liability release contained in this document.

**Exclusive Governing Law and Jurisdiction:** This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Washington, without regard to conflicts of laws principles. If the right to seek arbitration is for any reason waived by both parties, or if judicial review of any arbitration is sought, any action or legal proceeding arising out of this Agreement shall be brought exclusively in the courts of the State of Washington, or, if it has or can acquire jurisdiction, in the United States District Court for the Western District of Washington or the appropriate appellate courts, and the parties hereby waive any objection to venue or jurisdiction in connection therewith. In connection with any action or legal proceeding arising out of this Agreement, the parties hereby specifically and knowingly waive any rights that either party might have to demand a jury trial.

By registering for the Tour, the Participant agrees to the Operator-Participant Contract and Terms and Conditions set forth in this Agreement.

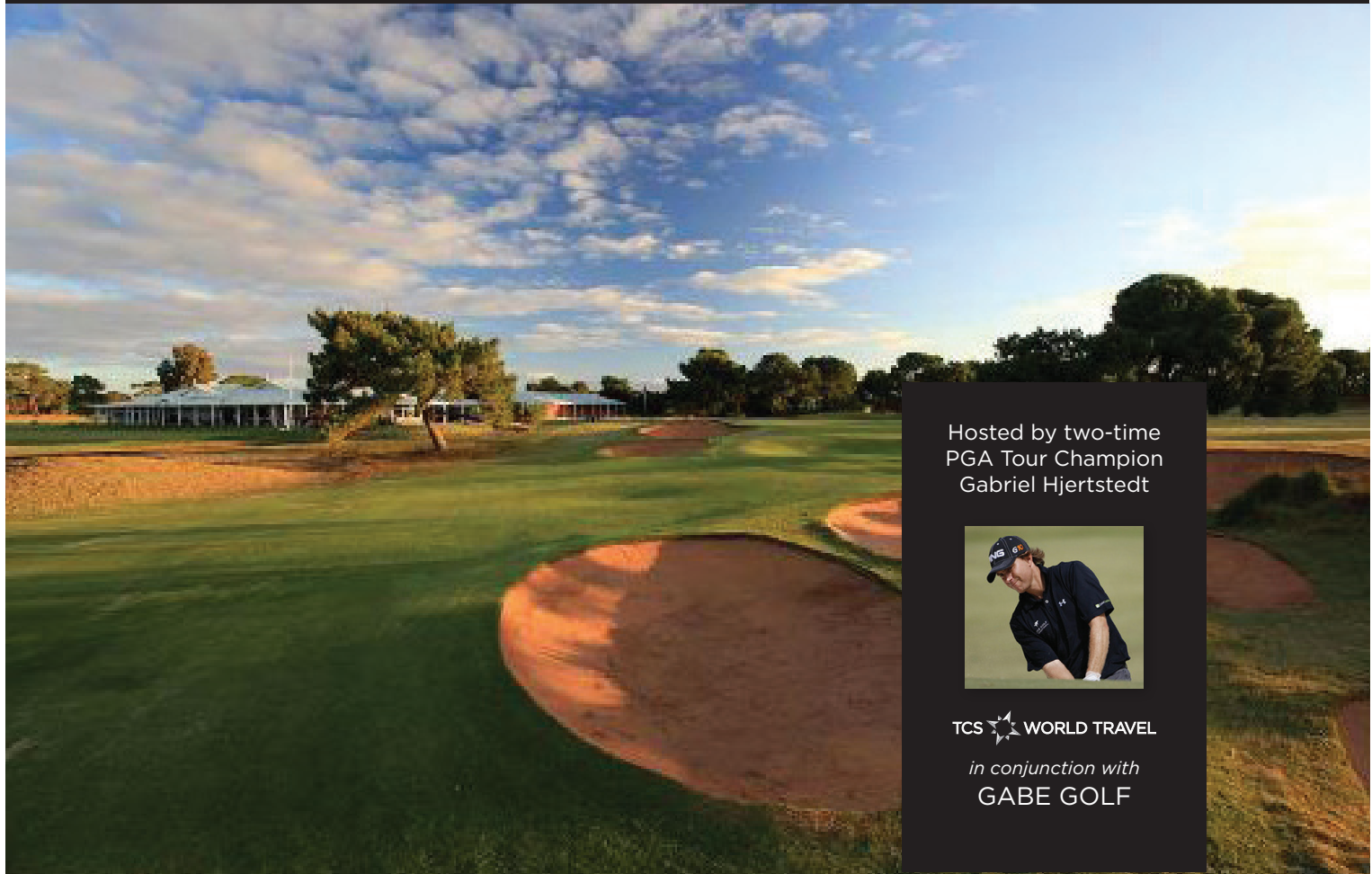
